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Membership of the MSSP	The MSSP Membership (Macclesfield School Sports Partnership) provides us with access to a range of PE training, and access to specialist PE teachers and coaches who can work with both staff and children at Lostock, enhancing PE provision. A wide variety of Sports Events are organised for many of our pupils to participate and experience competitions and Festivals with other local schools	£1500	Children’s involvement and participation in a range of Level 2 and Level 3 sporting events, leading to greater depth of learning of relevant skills, teamwork and sportsmanship. How Impact is measured.

- Sports Coaches work alongside class teachers to track children’s progress in P.E. This is recorded on our school tracking system and is analysed at our tracking meetings.
- Our School sports ambassadors regularly interview pupils about their feelings on sport at school;
